Summer Learning Activities to get your child ready for 1st grade

Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read for 10 - 15 minutes a day or read to your child each day for 10 - 15 minutes • Practice rhyming • Listen to words and identify the beginning and ending sounds • Work on short vowel sounds (i.e cat /a/ is the short vowel sound)
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have your child write and draw in a journal about their summer activities • Work on sounding out words when writing • Practice writing uppercase and lowercase letters and numbers. Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s • Practice basic addition and subtraction facts (you can even use things around the house to count)
Social Studies/Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore the city • Visit your local library • Use your five senses while observing your neighborhood - what do you see, touch, taste, smell, hear? • Draw and label maps of places near where you live • Learn your address, neighborhood, city, state, and country (and phone number)
