Assessments

All tests, quizzes, and other graded assignments will be sent home periodically in a designated Take Home folder. Each item in the folder should be signed by a parent and returned the following school day.

Attendance

A written or emailed excuse note is expected after a student is absent. Homework will be due upon return.

School Supplies:

Please find a copy of the supply list on the McCall Website and below. We are kindly requesting that your child have his/her supplies when we return to school.

Uniforms:

Students need to wear the appropriate McCall School uniform everyday. Tops are solid white and bottoms are solid blue. **Blue jeans are not allowed.** In the colder months, a <u>solid</u> blue or white sweater is preferred. Students will be sent to the main office and you will be contacted if your child is not in an appropriate uniform.

Schedule: (admission/dismissal)
