

## 102 Supply Fee

Instead of issuing a supply list, I collect a supply fee and order the items in bulk for the classroom. I have found that this saves parents time and money, while ensuring that students have exactly what they need from Day 1. It also helps keep the kids' things more organized, since materials are distributed when needed.

Assuming a class of 30 students, the supply fee for the 2025-2026 school year will be \$21. Note that this number may adjust depending on enrollment/ price changes over the summer. The supply fee will cover:

Total	574+45.92 (8% tax)= 619.92

Additionally, students need a pair of wired headphones to be kept at school. I also suggest sending a wired mouse for your child's chromebook. If your child uses a trackpad on a laptop well, then a mouse is not necessary.
