Ms. Diletto's Summer Learning Activities to get your child ready for 1st grade

Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read for 10 - 15 minutes a day or read to your child each day for 10 - 15 minutes• Practice rhyming• Listen to words and identify the beginning and ending sounds• Master all letters and sounds• Work on short vowel sounds (i.e cat /a/ is the short vowel sound)• Memorize kindergarten and 1st grade sight words
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have your child write and draw in a journal about their summer activities• Work on sounding out words when writing• Practice writing uppercase and lowercase letters and numbers. We will be using this paper to write this year file:///Users/teacher/Downloads/_Composition%20Paper%20Portrait%20(Large%20Grids).pdf
Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s• Practice basic addition and subtraction facts (you can even use things around the house to count)
Social Studies/Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explore the city• Visit your local library• Use your five senses while observing your neighborhood - what do you see, touch, taste, smell, hear?• Draw and label maps of places near where you live• Learn your address, neighborhood, city, state, and country (and phone number)
